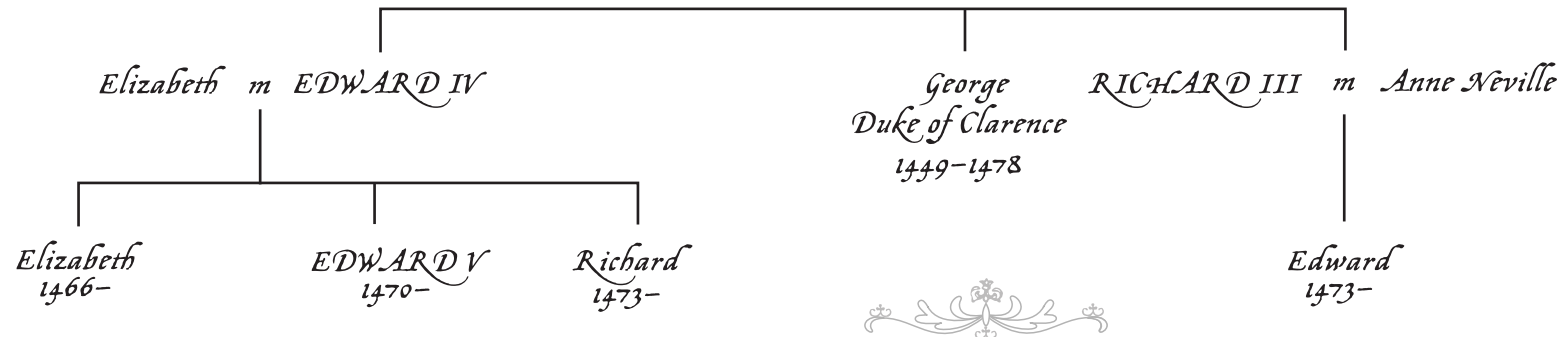


*Elizabeth Woodville's
